Instructions

How to treat sneakers against odor

This instruction provides a short overview of how to use Prebona OdorControl to eliminate unwanted odors in sneakers and shoes.

Before treating sneakers against bad odor, make sure the sneakers are clean and dry. Treatment with Prebona OdorControl will remove unwanted odors that are present in sneakers. The odor eliminating effect of Prebona DuraClean is almost immediate, i.e. the odor is eliminated within minutes, and typically lasts for a few days up to several weeks depending on conditions. Sometimes it is necessary to repeat treatment for best result. For more information on what odors are eliminated and expected effect, visit www.prebona.com. Re-apply Prebona OdorControl regularly to maintain odor-free sneakers.

When applying Prebona OdorControl with a spray bottle, aim at the inside of the sneakers. Avoid spraying surfaces that should not be treated, e.g. the outside of the sneakers, as Prebona OdorControl may leave white marks that can be difficult to remove if let to dry. If Prebona OdorControl is applied to an unwanted surface, wipe off immediately with a moist cloth before drying. If Prebona OdorControl is let to dry on a non-absorbing surface and marks are visible, use an appropriate detergent, depending on surface, to remove the white marks.

When applying OdorControl, the temperature should be above +5°C. Before use, read safety data sheet, available at www.prebona.com, and use safety gear according to instructions. Avoid breathing spray mist.

3 easy steps to treat sneakers with Prebona OdorControl:

1. Make sure the sneakers are clean and dry. Open up the sneakers for easy access.
2. Apply Prebona OdorControl with a spray bottle. Spray until inside of the sneaker is moist, about 3 to 5 sprays per sneaker.
3. Let the sneakers dry.
